Host Region Descriptions

Akaroa and Banks Peninsula

Banks Peninsula is made up of two extinct volcanoes and the deep harbour, secluded coves and bays, offer a great variety of land and sea experiences. Akaroa known as nature's playground is located just a 90-minute drive from Christchurch. This seaside village, on the crater rim, with its unique French heritage, beautiful scenery and stunning harbour, is home to the rare Hector's Dolphins, Little Blue Penguins and a myriad of other wildlife and marine birds. Visitors can enjoy a harbour cruise, one of the many scenic walks, ranging from an hour to a three-day trek, or simply relax and revive in this idyllic seaside location. Sample the huge range of local produce- from delicious Akaroa Salmon- to our locally produced cheeses and take time to stroll through this historic town and enjoy the wide selection of boutique shops and galleries.

Hurunui

Hurunui district is a place where rugged coastlines and breath-taking clifftops meet lush forests and alpine retreats. 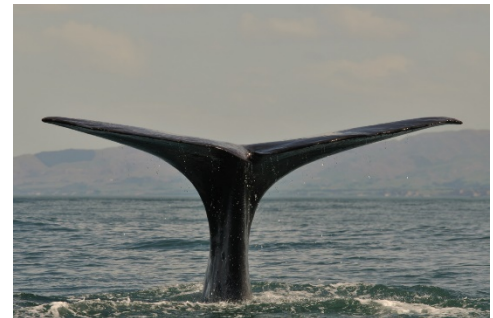
